THE USA PATRIOT ACT OF 2001

- a. has a written anti-money laundering program that complies with the USA PATRIOT ACT and the Bank Secrecy Act, or
- b. is not a "dealer in precious metals, stones, and jewels" as defined in the USA PATRIOT Act, or
- c. is exempt from compliance therewith by one of the following:

Retailer exemption. Retailers that purchase only from other dealers who follow a U.S. anti-money laundering program are exempt from compliance. Additionally, retailers who purchase less than \$50,000 of covered goods from non-U.S. dealers and members of the general public are exempt from compliance.

Pawnbroker exemption. Business properly licensed and registered as pawnbrokers under state or municipal law are specifically exempted from the Interim Final Rule's definition of "dealer", and are not required to comply.

Comprehensive Written Information Security Program

Bay Precious Metals has a Comprehensive written information security program.

The purpose of the Program is to:

- a. Ensure the security and confidentiality of personal information.
- b. Protect against any anticipated threats or hazards to the security or integrity of such information.
- c. Protect against unauthorized access to and use of such information in a matter that creates a substantial risk of identity theft or fraud.
